A recent study by the University of Michigan on 23,000 General Motors employees found that adding two or more days of light exercise lowered costs by an average of \$500.00 per employee a year.

According to Cornell University Institute for Health and Productivity Studies, a company investment of \$100.00 - \$150.00 per employee each year to participate in an employee wellness program can save companies \$300 to \$450.00 per employee each year (savings may take a few years to actualize).

Obesity has been identified as the single largest contributing factor to rising health care costs for U.S. employers. Overweight employees have higher medical expenses than normal weight employees.

The costs of obesity to U.S. businesses for health care, sick leave and disability insurance are now estimated at \$12.7 billion a year (American Journal of Health Promotion).

Obesity is associated with 39 million lost workdays and 63 million doctor visits a year (National Business Group on Health).

Exercise has been proven to reduce and/or prevent illness and reduce stress. The benefits of reducing one or both can improve an employee's productivity level, decrease the amount of sick days used, improve employee morale and increase the employer's bottom line.
